I. Reflect on the Beginning of the End (11)

A) The Urgency of the Time

July - Bass Lake Camp, 'No Turning Back, Luke 9:62. Make it a priority this summer to get away from the world and spend time learning and getting close to our Lord. And of course, have fun.

B) The Immanence of Christ's Return

Total cost is \$310*, of which our church pays \$130, leaving \$180 for the camper to pay. If the camper can not afford this, there is money available to assist with the camper portion. See Pastor or Mike Hulsizer with questions about this. **IMPORTANT**, Do not register on line, instead use the paper forms and give them along with the \$75 deposit to Mike Hulsizer or Pastor Delich. We need them so we can take care of the church portion and arranging rides. Camp cost goes up to \$350 after May 1, so register early.

II. Walk in Holiness (12-14)

A) Put Off

Camp workers are needed, Counselors, Teen staff, Lifeguards, Adult helpers. If you can help in any of these areas please see Pastor Delich or Mike Hulsizer.

B) Put On
