December 24 - 5:00 PM - Christmas Eve service

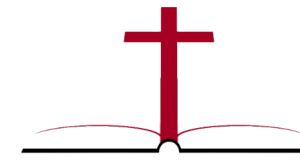
December 31 - 5:00 PM - New Year's Eve Church wide game night. Food, games, fellowship.
